Regulation

The Cultural Association "PEGASUS CATTOLICA" with the Institutional Patrons and the Logos Cultura Association, organizes the **8 th Edition of the Milano International Literary Prize** divided into five sections.

Section published works of fiction, poetry or non-fiction in Italian in vernacular or foreign language.

Section Unpublished works of poetry in Italian, in Vernacular or Foreign.

Section Unpublished works of fiction in Italian, in Vernacular or Foreign.

Unpublished poetic Silloge section in Italian or in Vernacular.

Unpublished novel section or collection of short stories in Italian or in the vernacular.

For works in languages other than Italian, English, Spanish or French, a specific translation must be sent. The theme is free.

It is possible to participate in the published works section with more works, (in this case the fee is multiple) for the poetry and short stories sections, with a maximum of three works, in the silloge section, novels and collection of short stories with more elaborates (in this case the quota is multiple). Each competitor can freely participate in several sections.

ART. 1

Registration for the competition is open to all European and non-European citizens. Membership by minors must be countersigned by the person exercising the authority.

ART. 2

ART. 3

As regards the participating works, they must be sent as follows:

Published works:

1 copy of the book and 1 copy of the cover if in pdf. - 2 copies of the book if on paper

Unpublished works: (Font 12 Times new Roman or Garamond or Arial)

Poems 1 copy in pdf The poems must be inserted in a single file in succession. 3 copies if on paper.

Unpublished stories 1 copy in pdf the stories must be inserted in one file in succession. 3 copies if on paper.

Novels or collections 1 copy in **word**. 3 copies if on paper The works must be accompanied by a short synopsis and short biography.

Poetic syllogs 1 copy in **word** format 3 copies if on paper The works must be accompanied by a short biography

ART. 4

The awarded works published will not be returned. Unpublished ones will be destroyed to protect the Copyright.

The winners must personally collect the prizes or send a trusted person during the event.

The prizes will consist of cash checks, trophies, plaques and publications with the **Pegasus Edition** publishing house.

The cash prizes in particular must be collected personally as they are intended as an attendance fee, the checks not withdrawn will constitute the prize fund for subsequent editions, for all other prizes, collection by proxy or shipping upon payment expected expenses.

Other possible prizes may be instituted during the work by the Association, the decision of the commission in charge will be final and unappealable. In case of Ex Aequo the prize will be divided equally among the participants

The winners of the five sections of the prizes, of the jury prizes, of the critics and of the merit prizes, **will be notified by phone, email, or letter at least 15 days before the date of the award ceremony.**

However, all participants will be able to consult the minutes of the winners which will be published directly on the official website of the award **on November 5, 2024. There is no communication for those who are not winners, the minutes published on the official website will prevail.**

ART. 7

There are no reimbursements for hotel and travel expenses. Those who have participated in the the Switzerland Literary Prize 2024 or the International Montefiore Prize 2024 and wish to **participate in this competition with the same published work (this article applies only to published works) will be able to avoid sending two copies of the work itself as they are already in possession of the organization.** (specify in the participation coupon).

ART. 8

For the purposes of the most complete seriousness and transparency, it is specified that the participation of former jurors, presidents, honorary members and collaborators of the events organized by the Pegasus association as well as the authors of the Pegasus Edition with a valid contract is not allowed.
